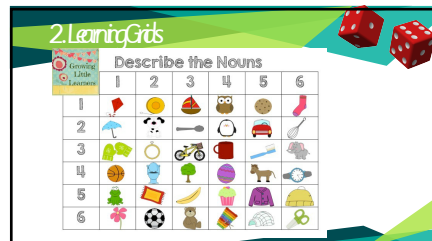

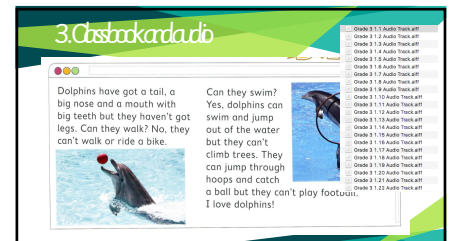

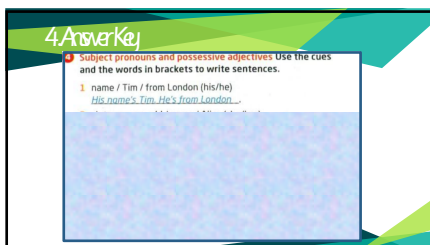
- Student selection
- “Homework bingo”



- The students work in pairs, rolling a dice to get the coordinates of the square they need to work on. The square they roll dictates the task they complete. The element of chance keeps students focused and creates an added element of challenge as they have to continuously shift gears with their thinking depending on what numbers they roll.



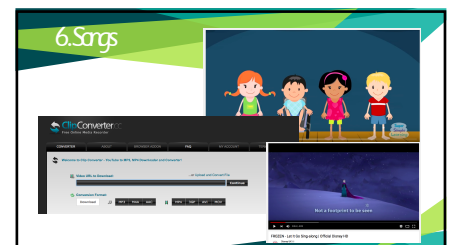
- Cut and paste parts of the book (PDF) into Powerpoint to focus attention and avoid distraction.
- Find the PDF on Google Drive.
- Download all of the audio from the book's CD to a laptop.



- Slow reveal the answer keys so that students can correct their own class/homework
- + Cuts down on paper
- + Keeps everyone at the same pace



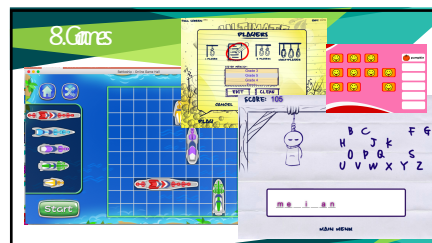

- Demonstrate boardgames, crafts and worksheets before starting the task or handing out materials.



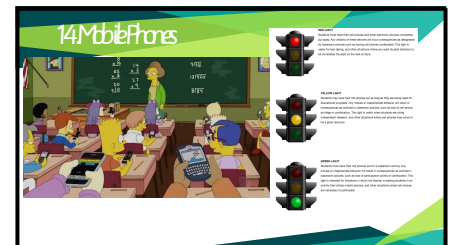

- Play background music during writing tasks or as a signal in speaking tasks (e.g. when the music stops find another partner to speak to).

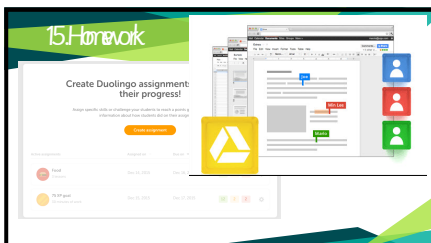
